Innovation Challenges are co-organized by the NATO Innovation Hub, located at Allied Command Transformation Headquarters (Norfolk, USA), and NATO Nations. With two Innovation Challenges a year, each edition is hosted by a different Nation on a different topic.

Brings together a community of experts

Abstracts are assessed online by a pool of experts from NATO and non NATO organizations on 3 criteria: feasibility, innovativeness and usefulness.

Open to all NATO Nations

A scenario-based innovation challenge that focuses on problem solving. Flexible format to attract all innovators: academia, industry, start-ups. Brings international visibility to participants and access to Innovative solutions for NATO.

A monetary prize for the 3 winners. Relevant solutions could support the development of future NATO concepts, doctrine, standards, requirements, capability development, and will get stagetime at NATO-wide events.

And after the NATO Innovation Challenge?

- 1. Topic definition with Host Nation, NATO Innovation Hub and NATO end-user.
- **2.** Abstracts online submission phase.
- 3. Preselection phase.
- **4.** Online and/or on-site finale between 10 finalists.
